WELCOME TO JSCYC! You are in for a wonderful week of worship, Bible study, fellowship, and recreation at beautiful Taylor Christian Camp. You will make new friends and establish lifelong relationships. Your family and friends may write to you at the Scottsville, KY address on the front cover. You are to <u>keep this booklet</u> for reference to the rules/regulations and schedules for camp week.

You will need to have brought the following items: **your Bible**, pencil/pen, note pad, comfortable clothing, play clothes, swimsuit, bathrobe, bed linens, blanket, pillow, towels, wash cloths, ball glove, sneakers/athletic shoes, and toiletry articles (soap, shampoo, etc.). If you like to fish, bring fishing equipment. For that occasional rainy day, you might want to bring an indoor game.

Each family and/or congregation will be responsible for providing transportation for their campers to and from camp. If some congregations have buses/vans, they might want to meet at a central location and ride together.

Please avoid packing your clothes and other articles in plastic bags as they tear easily, and items become lost or soiled. Duffle bags, suitcases, or plastic tubs will work fine.

You will need some money for use in the canteen, but do not bring a large amount. (A drink and snack from the canteen cost about a couple of dollars or slightly more). It would be better to bring small bills (ones, fives, tens) instead of twenties. The camp will not be responsible for any lost money or valuable items. We do our best to get money turned in to Lost & Found back to the rightful owner.

Campers and counselors should arrive at camp on Sunday afternoon in time (preferably around 2:00-3:00 P.M.), to get into your cabin, get it in order, and prepare for the evening meal at 6:00 P.M. and the worship service to follow. <u>We MUST depart from camp on Friday,</u> <u>July 18th by 6 P.M.</u> If your parents are picking you up, please advise them of the departure deadline. Parents, please make arrangements to be here to pick up your campers by the above date and time.

Your directors, counselor(s), teachers and all the staff are here to assist you with any problem which arises. We hope you have a safe, enjoyable, and, above all, spiritually uplifting week!

RULES & REGULATIONS (Keep These Handy)

- 1. The Camp Directors will always have complete authority.
- 2. The campers will be required to carry out all official requests of staff members.
- The swimming area and creek area are OFF LIMITS to all campers from time of arrival, except at designated times, and then only with a counselor(s) present. The BUG is off-limits and is to be covered.
- 4. Campers are required to keep their own cabins clean. There will be daily cabin inspection. No camper is to enter another cabin without counselors' permission or for official business. All campers and counselors are to respect the bunk, cubby space, and belongings of other campers and counselors.
- **5.** Boys are forbidden to visit girls' quarters except for official business and then only with permission.
- **6.** Girls are forbidden to visit boys' quarters except for official business and then only with permission.
- Dresses, pants, or jeans must be worn by girls for devotional group assemblies. Girls may wear jeans to class. but no shorts are to be worn to class by girls or boys.
- **8.** Pants or jeans, with shirts, must be worn by boys for class and group assemblies unless otherwise announced.
- 9. Three primary rules for dress code have been established:
 - a. No shorts may be worn, by boys, girls, or counselors, that are more than three (3) inches above the knee (credit card width).
 - b. No see-through shirts or shirts which expose the midriff may be worn, by boys or girls or counselors.
 - c. No tank tops or cut out T-shirts are to be worn by either boys or girls or counselors.
 - d. No biker shorts or yoga pants.
- **10.** Campers must conduct themselves as always becoming young ladies and gentlemen. Profanity and rough play are strictly forbidden.
- **11.** Any camper needing medical attention must report to camp director or nurse immediately. Insurance is carried on each camper and staff member.
- **12.** Each camper is to attend every assembly of classes, all devotionals, and organized sports unless excused by a nurse for medical reasons.
- 13. No special privileges will be granted to any group of campers for special activities after lights out. (Example: Birthday party. After 11:00 P.M. all activities must be confined to individual cabins and must be of such nature as not to disturb any other campers). This applies to Thursday night as well!
- **14.** No one, including STAFF and CAMPERS, is to leave camp at any time without contacting the director.
- **15.** No counselor is to leave Friday until all packing and cleaning are done and all are ready to depart.
- **16.** No alcohol, tobacco products, or illegal drugs are permitted at camp by either campers or counselors.

NOTE: Be sure to keep this copy and familiarize yourself with these rules as they are provided for the safety and well-being of all campers and counselors.
